

Coalbrookdale Gazetteer addenda

- Railings, St Paul's Studios, Talgarth Road, c. 1891. There is some information on the houses here: <http://www.house-historian.co.uk/tag/st-pauls-studios/>. There may be further Coalbrookdale items inside the houses, potentially fireplaces.
- Hat and Umbrella stand, 1870, designed by Christopher Dresser, on display at the V&A
- Coat and Umbrella stand, 1850–1900, on display at the V&A
- Hat stand, c. 1880, designed by Christopher Dresser, on display at the V&A
- Fire surround, c. 1850, designed by Alfred Stevens, on display at the V&A
- 'The Milton Vase', c. 1856, electro-bonze, in storage at the V&A
- Two fruit dishes, c. 1840, one on display and one in storage at the V&A
